

COM 287: INDEPENDENT STUDY

Approval Form

COURSE DESCRIPTION – Intensive work in a special area of the student's interest. Each individual project is to culminate in a comprehensive written report or examination, or creative work. Open only to students who are not on academic probation and who have demonstrated an ability to profit from independent study. Maximum of 6 hours may be applied toward graduation.

PROJECT EXAMPLES - Historical research, original research, creative work, curriculum evaluation, pedogeological analysis, professional project, etc.

PREREQUISITES - Project approval by school director and instructor prior to registration. Requires 2.0 minimum major and cumulative GPA for communication majors and 2.50 minimum GPA for others.

HOW DO I REGISTER FOR AN INDEPENDENT STUDY?

Step 1: Determine which communication faculty member you would like to work with and contact for approval

Step 2: Meet with the faculty member to discuss project ideas and credit hour options

Step 3: Complete the below form with your faculty member

Step 4: Secure student and faculty member signatures

Step 5: Send the completed form to your assigned academic advisor
